Description of Duties

Under general supervision, performs moderately difficult professional civil engineering duties, reviews petitions and modifications to existing Lake Michigan water allocations and the collection of required annual and monthly water use data; prepares reports of water use and other reports; reviews permit applications for construction in and along the waters of regulated floodplains of the state, collects data required for completion of assigned projects and performs preliminary inspections of construction projects near Lake Michigan.

Requires knowledge, skill and mental development equivalent to completion of four years college with a degree in civil engineering. Requires one year professional experience in civil engineering.
